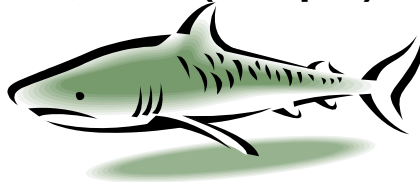


Don't Miss Out!

**Driving Directions:** From I-4 Westbound – Take Exit 1 Downtown East (22<sup>nd</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> Street), Turn left on 21<sup>st</sup> to Hwy.60 (Adamo Drive) Right on to Hwy.60 to Channelside Drive (Detour effective April 20: Left on McKay St., Follow signs for parking). You may unload in front of the Aquarium, then park. Visitors to the Aquarium can also take advantage of all there is to do in the Channel District in downtown Tampa.
